1. Registration and participation

- 1.1. I am over 18 years of age (or 16 to 18 years of age with parent consent form) on the date of the Event
- 1.2. The participant will enter the event at their own risk, no liability is to be held by the University Hospitals Dorset NHS Charity. This will include travel to and from the event.
